
#### PratyoushOnta, Dukha during the World War

Since then Gurkhas have fought alongside British troops thousands of miles away from home on foreign land. The Gurkhas are mostly from Rai, Limbu, Gurung and Magar ethnic group of Nepal's hill people. This is still a strong tradition among them.



















The Gurkhas first contact with the western world came during 1814-16 when the British East India Company waged a war against Nepal.Thus, impressed by the fighting skills of their


enemies, the British included the peace treaty with then Nepali government, allowing Gurkhas to serve in the British army. After that, Gurkhas would fight alongside the British troops, thousands of miles away from home on foreign land during the World War I, II.

"My grandfather name Kumbhashing Dhekhim Rai, father name Tilashmi Dhekhim Rai, mother name FulmatiYelabami yakkha. I was born in 1914 march 2,Monday. Now I'm writing this at the age of 95. I was joined ten Gorkha British in age of 21 (1935 AD). Age of 27, I fought in Balu chistan, Pakistan, Kabul, Uzbekistan against the Ujuris. Age of 28, I was stay in Jhashi, Bombay. Age of 29,30,31,32, I fought in Rangoon Burma against the Japan. After end of the war, Age of 33, I stay in Rangoon, Singapore,Java, Malaya,Imushingh,

Patani, and Penang. Age of 34, when India and British were going to be separate and we all the battalion gather in Alhi lalsansar while letter was coming from my home my mother and brother was dead. I had to come back to home but officers did not allow me to back home but i had to."






















